Any displaced person from Ukraine arriving in Luxembourg is asked to report to the Immigration Office of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs: immigration.desk@mae.etat.lu.

Parents coming from Ukraine with their **children** are asked to contact the *Service de la scolarisation des enfants étrangers* (SECAM) of the Ministry of Education 38 rue Philippe II L-2340 Luxembourg on +352 247-76570 (English) or +352 247-76976 (Ukrainian).

Anyone planning private transport to rescue people at the Ukrainian borders is asked to inform the relevant ministry: transport.ukraine@mae.etat.lu.

For all **consular questions** of people who are trying to leave Ukraine or are already in transit from Ukraine, it is advisable to send an email to the consular assistance of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs: assistance.consulaire@mae.etat.lu or contact the following number +352 2478 2386.
